- Rostow's Stages of Growth Model
- Singer & Prebisch's Dependency Theory
- Von Thunen Agricultural Bid-Rent Model
- Wallerstein's World System Theory
- Weber's Least Cost Model
- Zipf's Rank-Size Rule

(c) for each construct you chose, find ONE (1) example from one of your assigned nations or US states. Explain how it is an example (or demonstrates) the scientific construction in question. Please do not use the same country or state for all six scientific constructs you are explaining!

For extra credit, find examples for, and explain, more than six scientific constructs. Connect them to more examples from your assigned nations or US states.
