Follow the link above, and pick one of the images from the AP slideshow about 9/11. Pick ANY TWO (2) of the images, and for each one, please do each of the following:

(1) One short paragraph to describe what you see in the photograph – for example, the location, people, structures, arrangement of various elements, etc. Avoid personal feelings or interpretations. Write your description as if you're trying to help someone who has not seen the image before to visualize it. You should provide enough specific detail so that your teachers can tell which photograph you chose to write about! When doing an image analysis, it is helpful to split the image into quarters so that you can really think about all aspects of what you are seeing.

(2) One short paragraph to describe what you think the photographer was trying to capture. You are welcome to reference your personal feelings, associations and judgments about the image. Always anchor your subjective response in some specific piece of evidence from the image! For example, “I see....and it makes me think/feel that...”

(3) One short paragraph that makes connections to other prior knowledge you have, based on what you have studied and learned. These connections do not have to be related to 9/11. What assumptions can you make, or what prior experiences do you have, that can help you make a connection or comparison to what is depicted in this photograph?
